Alain Polguère is full professor in the Department of Linguistics and Translation at the University of Montreal. He is also the director of the research group *Observatoire de linguistique Sens-Texte* (OLST), that brings together researchers in linguistics, terminology and translation. After studying linguistics in France, he completed his Ph.D. dissertation in 1990 at the University of Montreal. In parallel with his studies, he worked in R&D in Montreal for several years, on the development of multilingual text generation systems. Later, from 1991 to 1995, he taught computational linguistics and lexicology at the National University of Singapore. He joined the University of Montreal in 1995. His current research activities focus on the development of rich formal lexical databases and on the problem of interfacing linguistic models for language learning and teaching.
