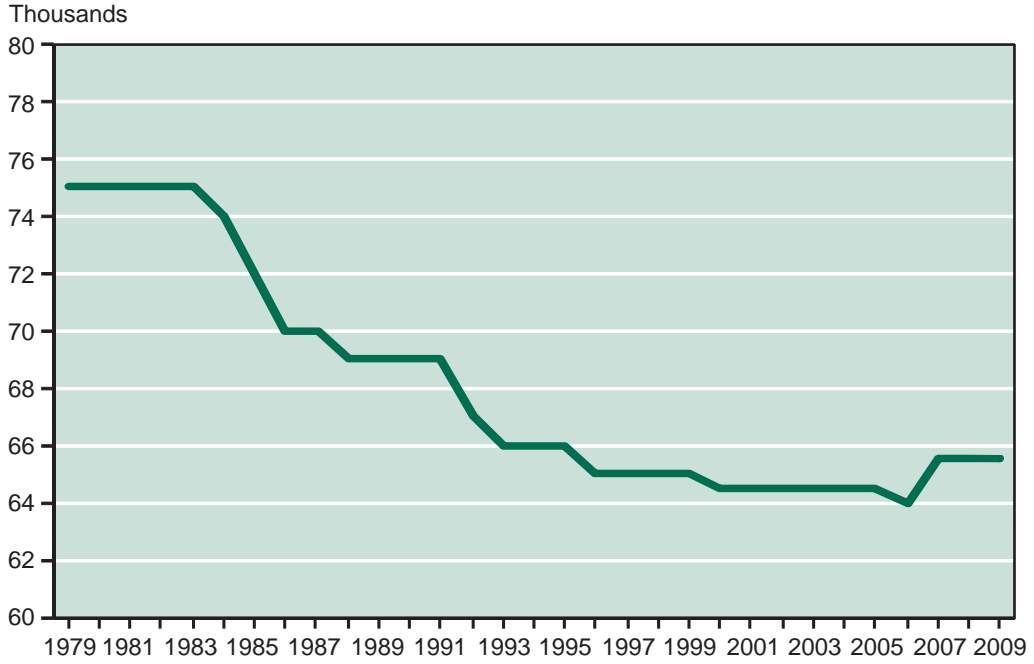


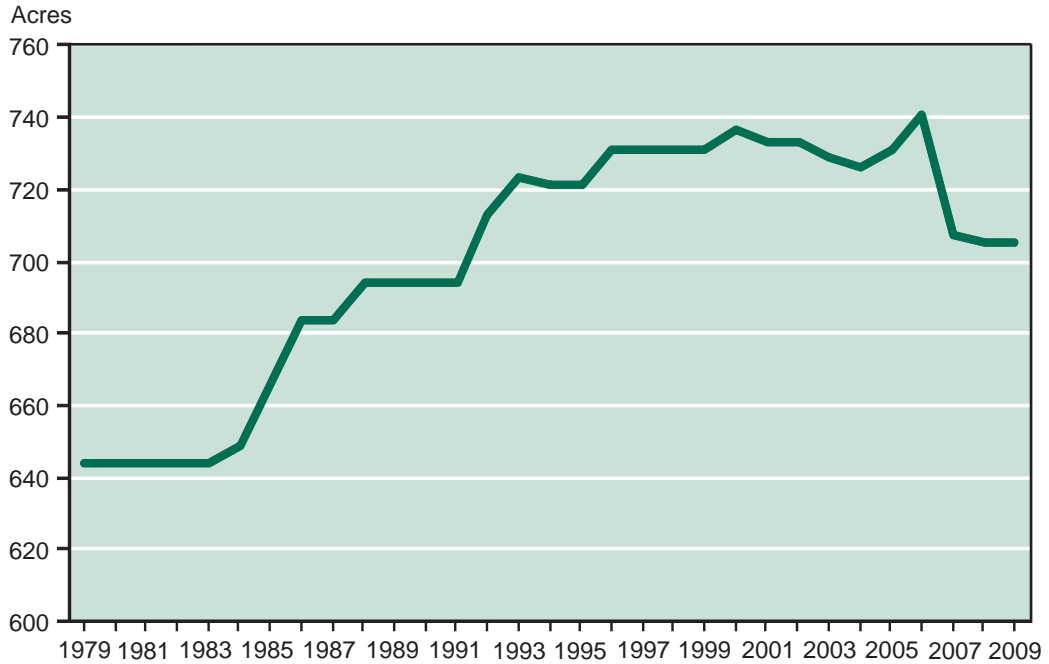

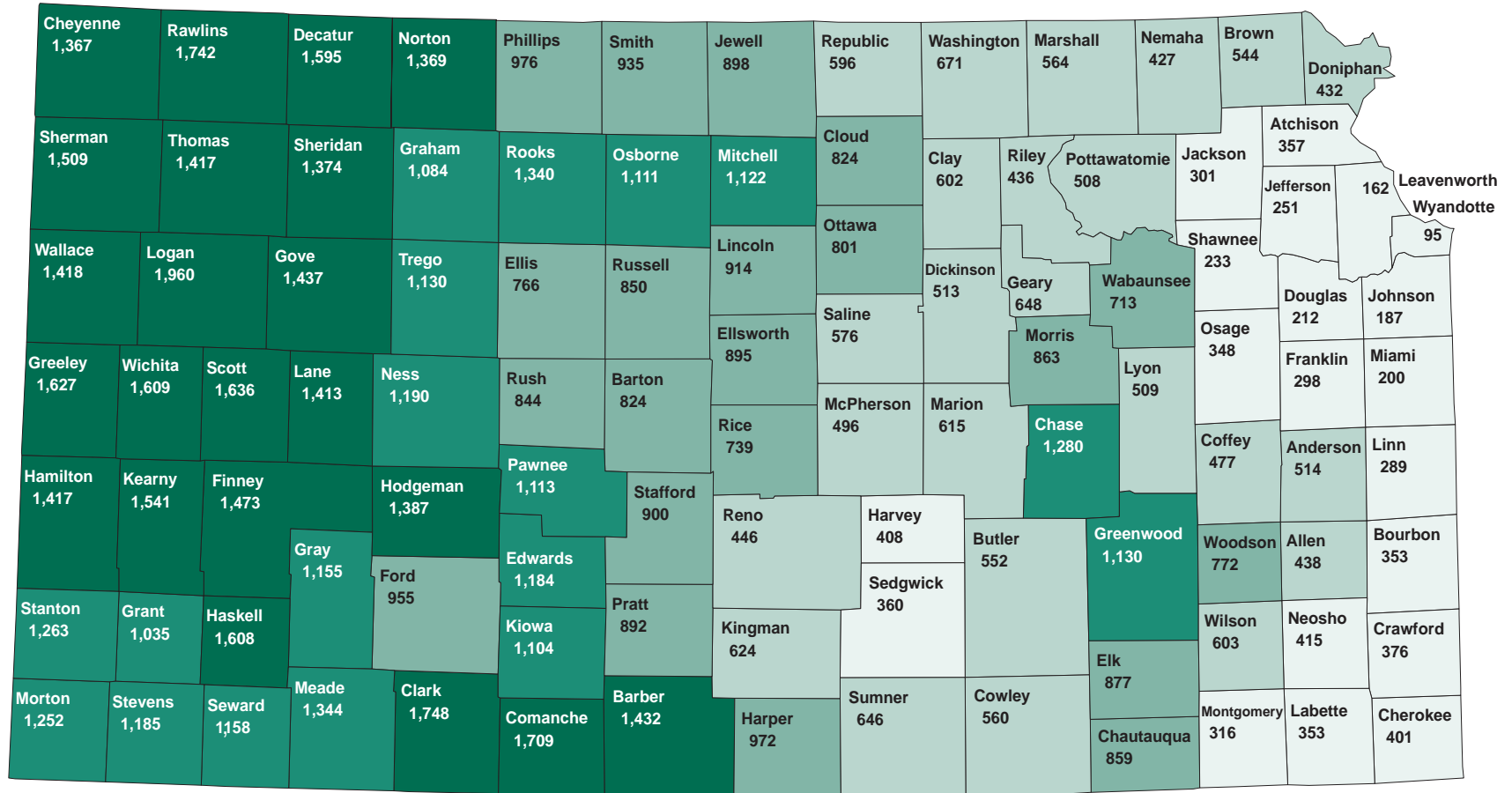

Beginning in 1975, a farm is defined as any place with annual sales of agricultural products of \$1,000 or more. Between 1959 and 1975 a farm was defined as a place of 10 or more acres that had annual sales of agricultural products of \$50 or more or a place of less than 10 acres that had annual sales of \$250 or more. Prior to 1959 a farm was defined as a place of three acres or more in size with a value of farm products amounting to \$150 or more. Places of less than three acres with sales of \$250 or more were also considered farms.

* Average per Farm is obtained by dividing Total Value by Farms.

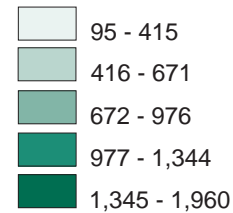
Average Farm Size in Kansas, by County, 2007 (in acres)

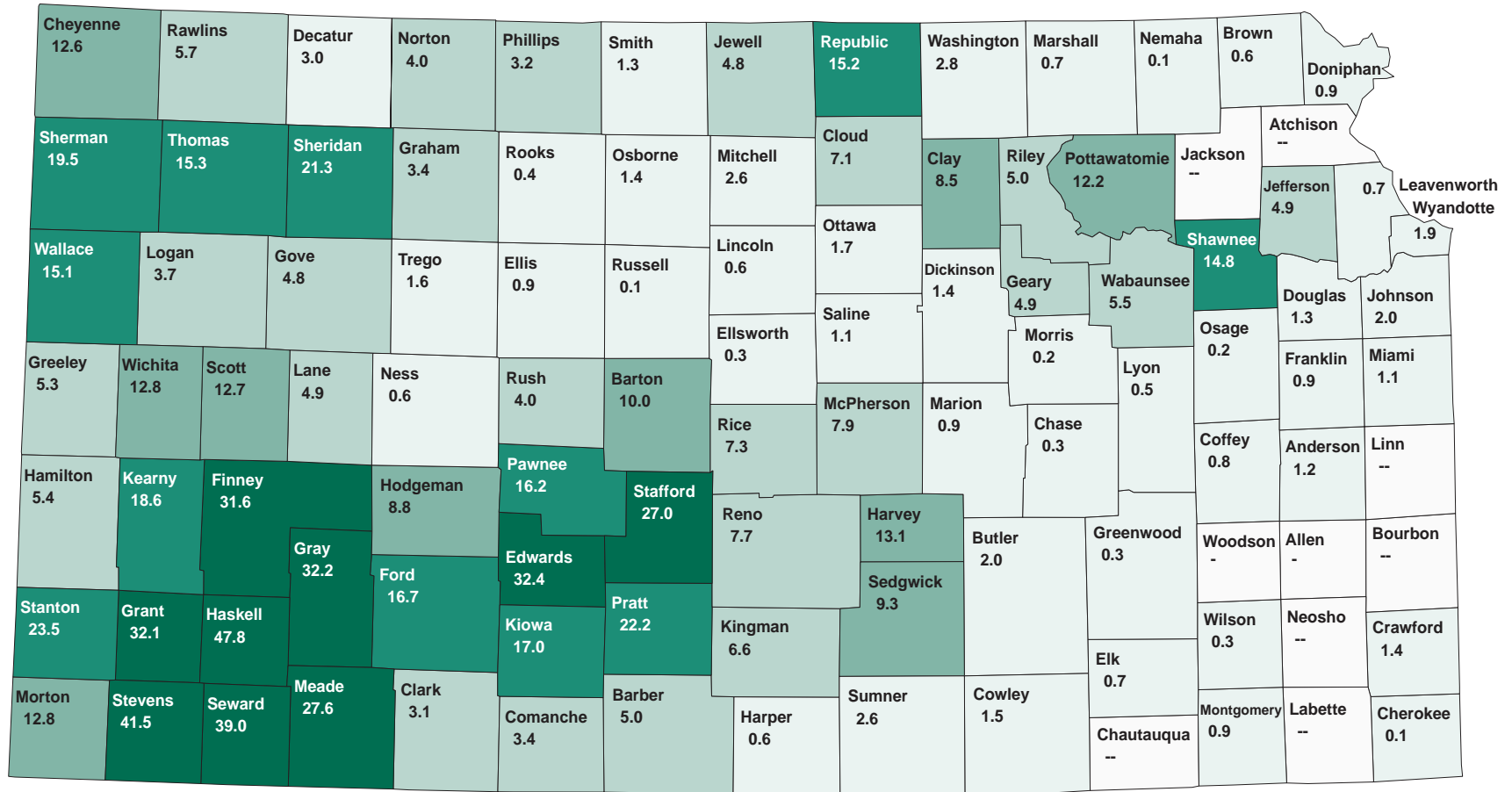

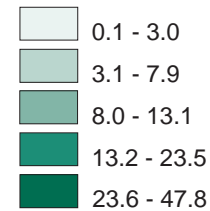
Percent of Cropland Irrigated in Kansas, by County, 2007

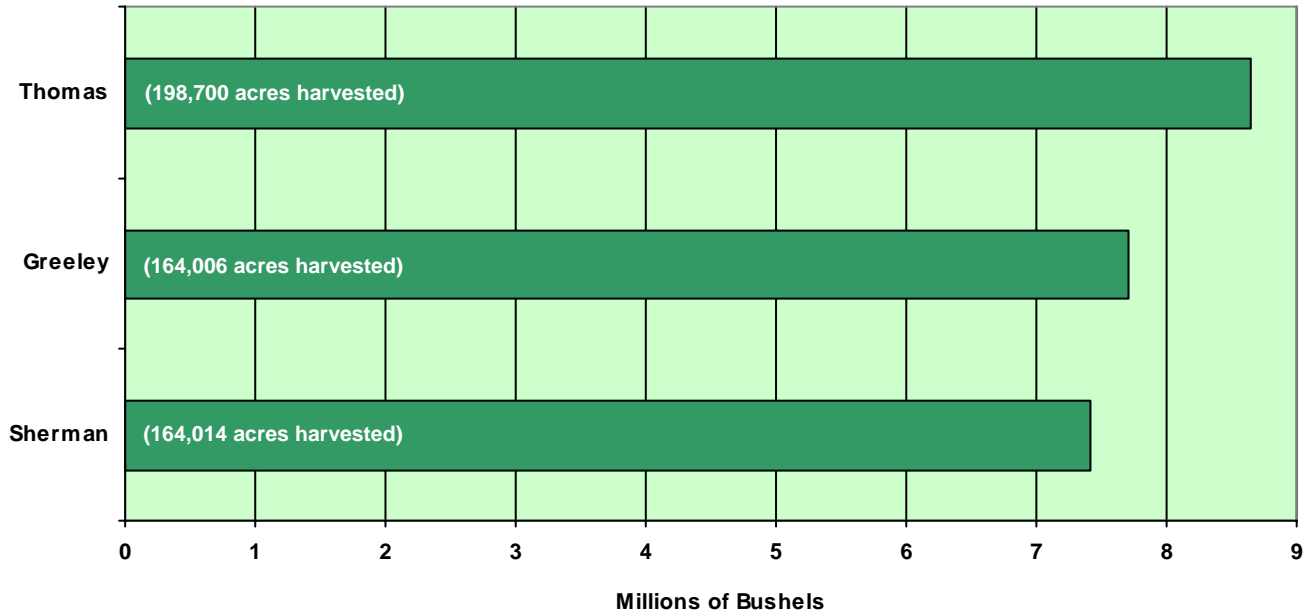

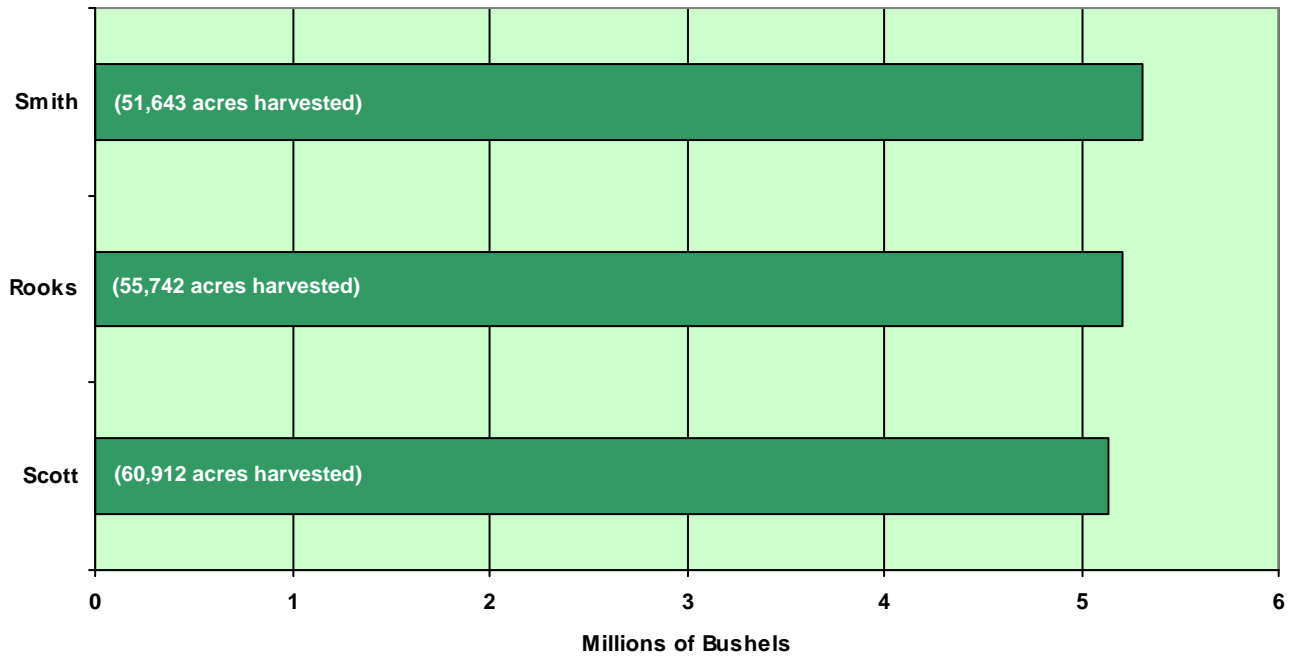

Wheat for Grain Bushels Harvested, 2007



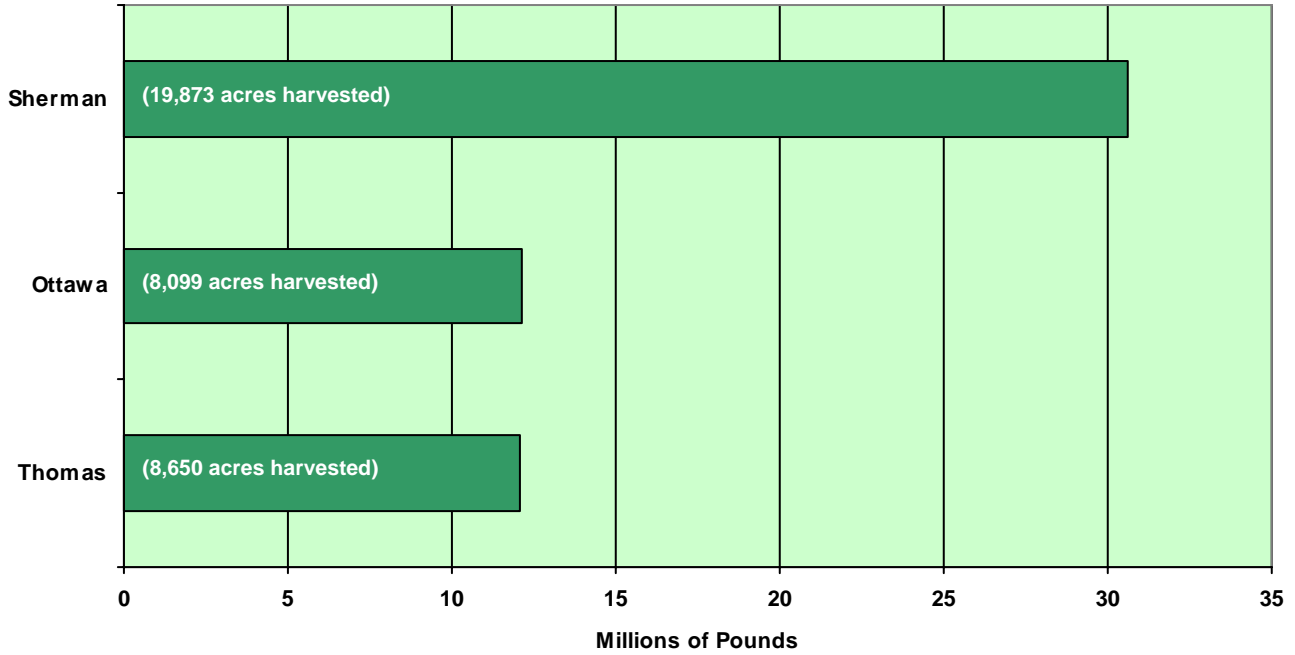
Sorghum for Grain Bushels Harvested, 2007



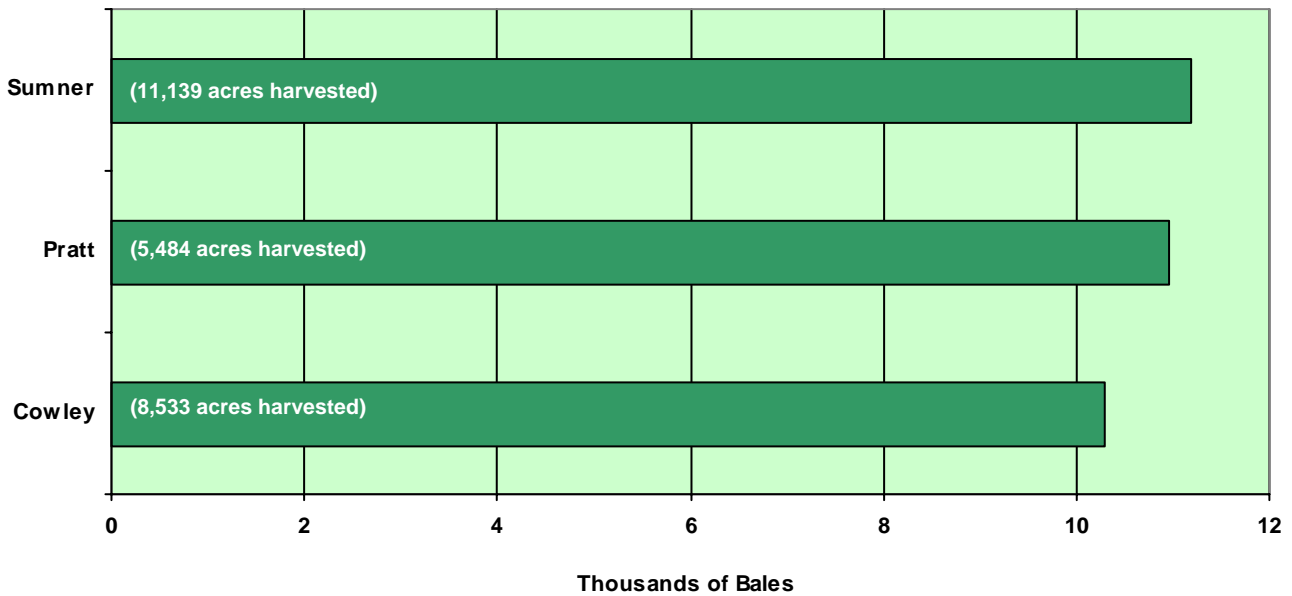

Sunflower Seed Pounds Harvested, 2007

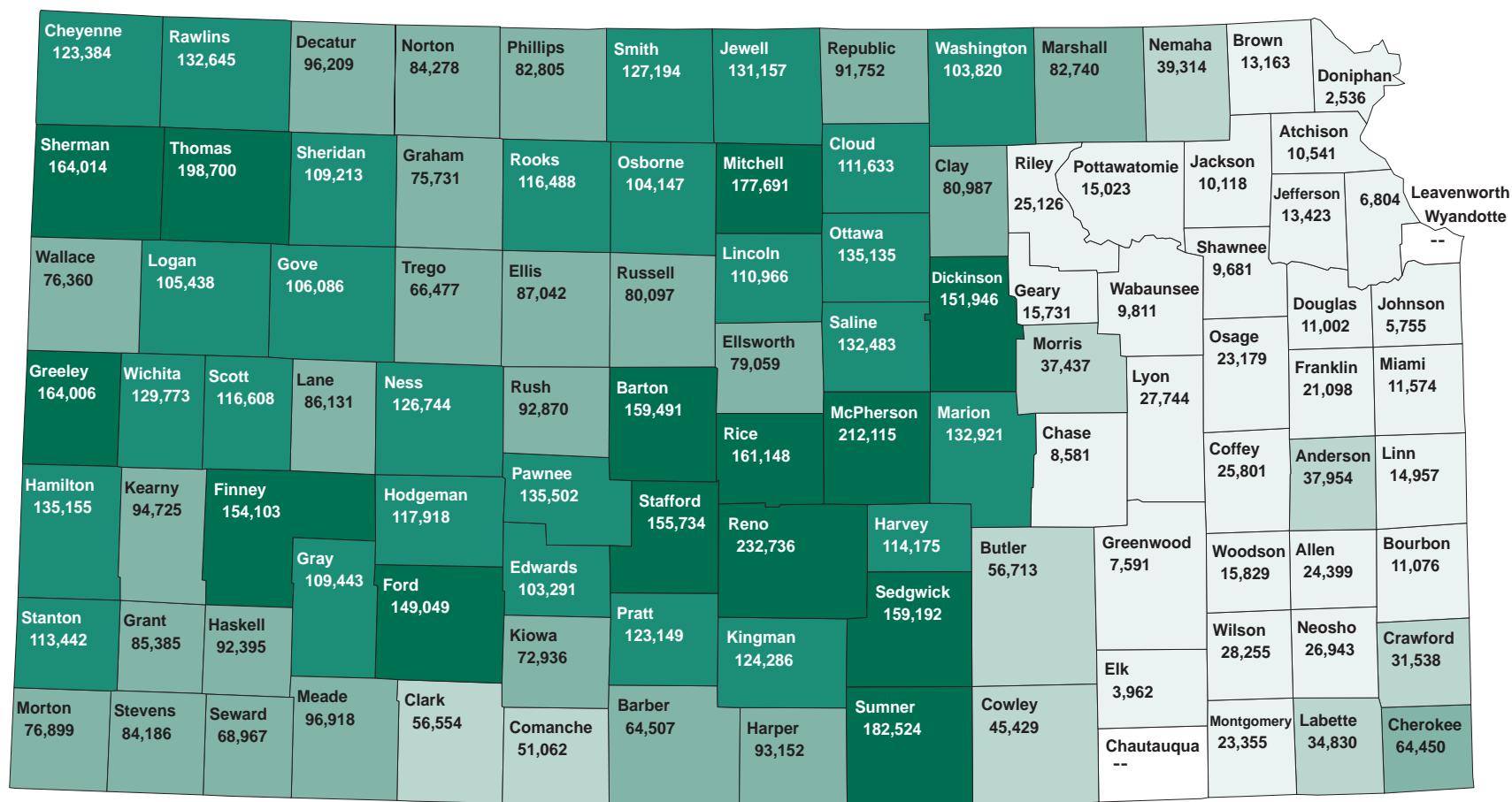


Cotton Bales Harvested, 2007

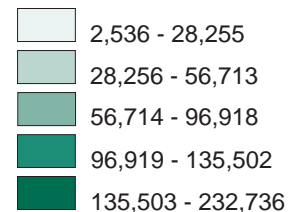
Acres of Wheat Harvested in Kansas, by County, 2007



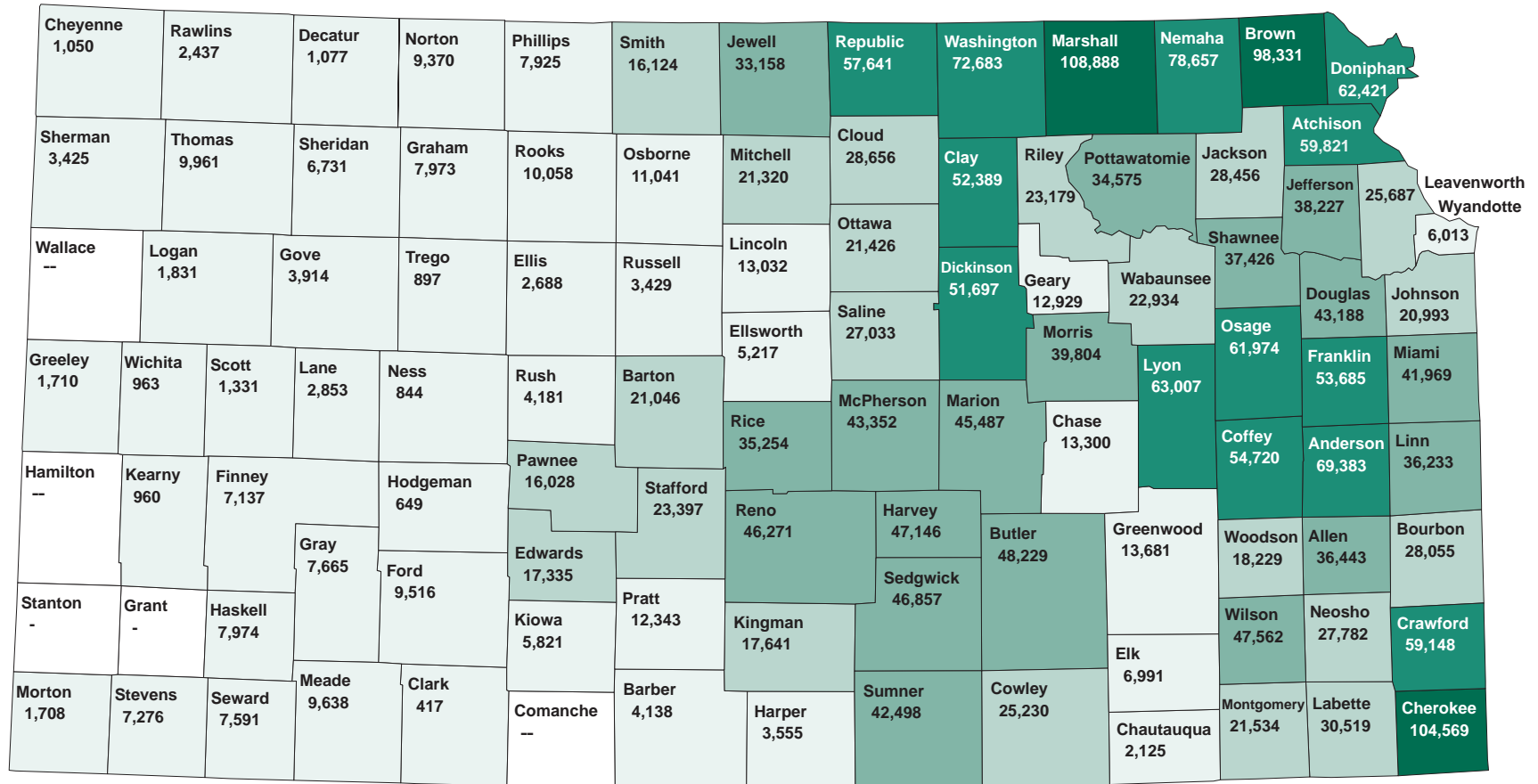

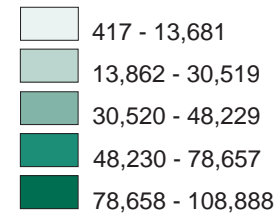
Acres of Soybeans Harvested in Kansas, by County, 2007

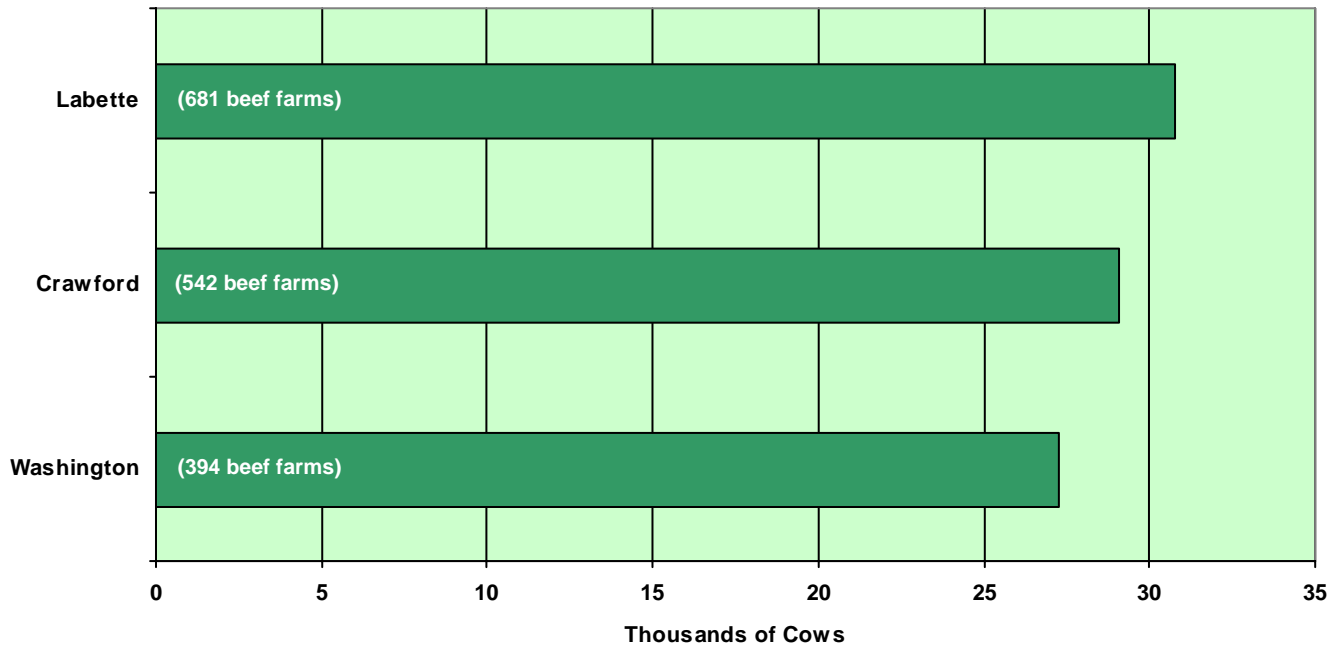

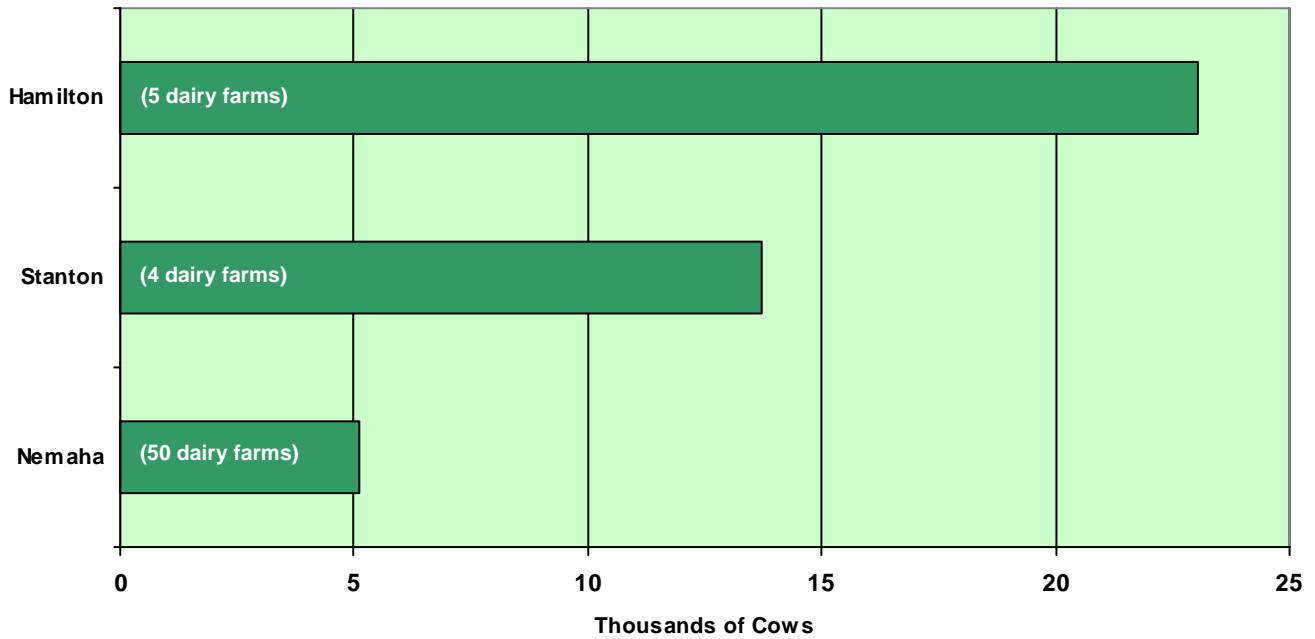

Beef Cows, 2007

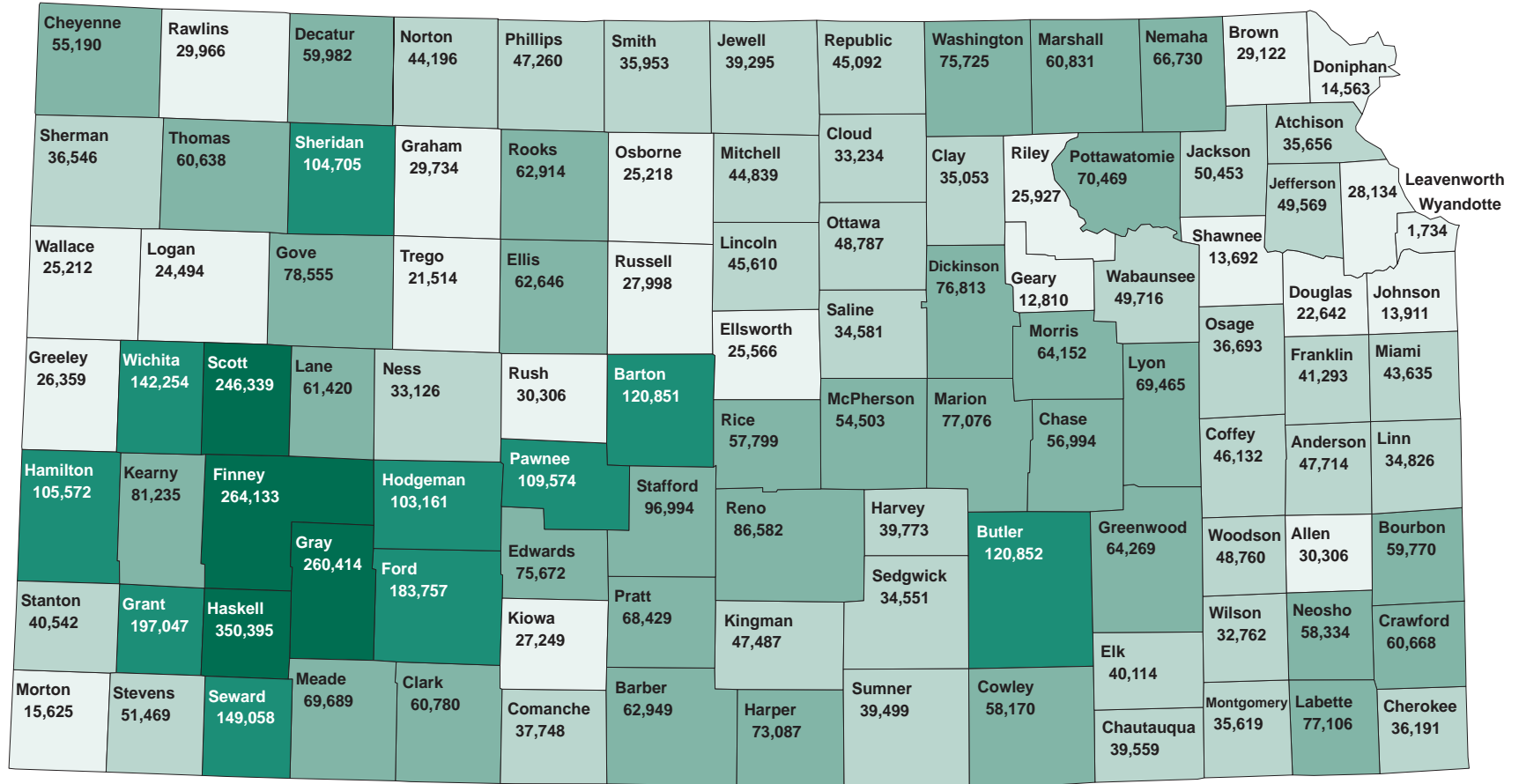


Milk Cows, 2007

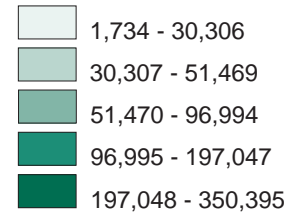
Cattle and Calves Inventory in Kansas, by County, 2007

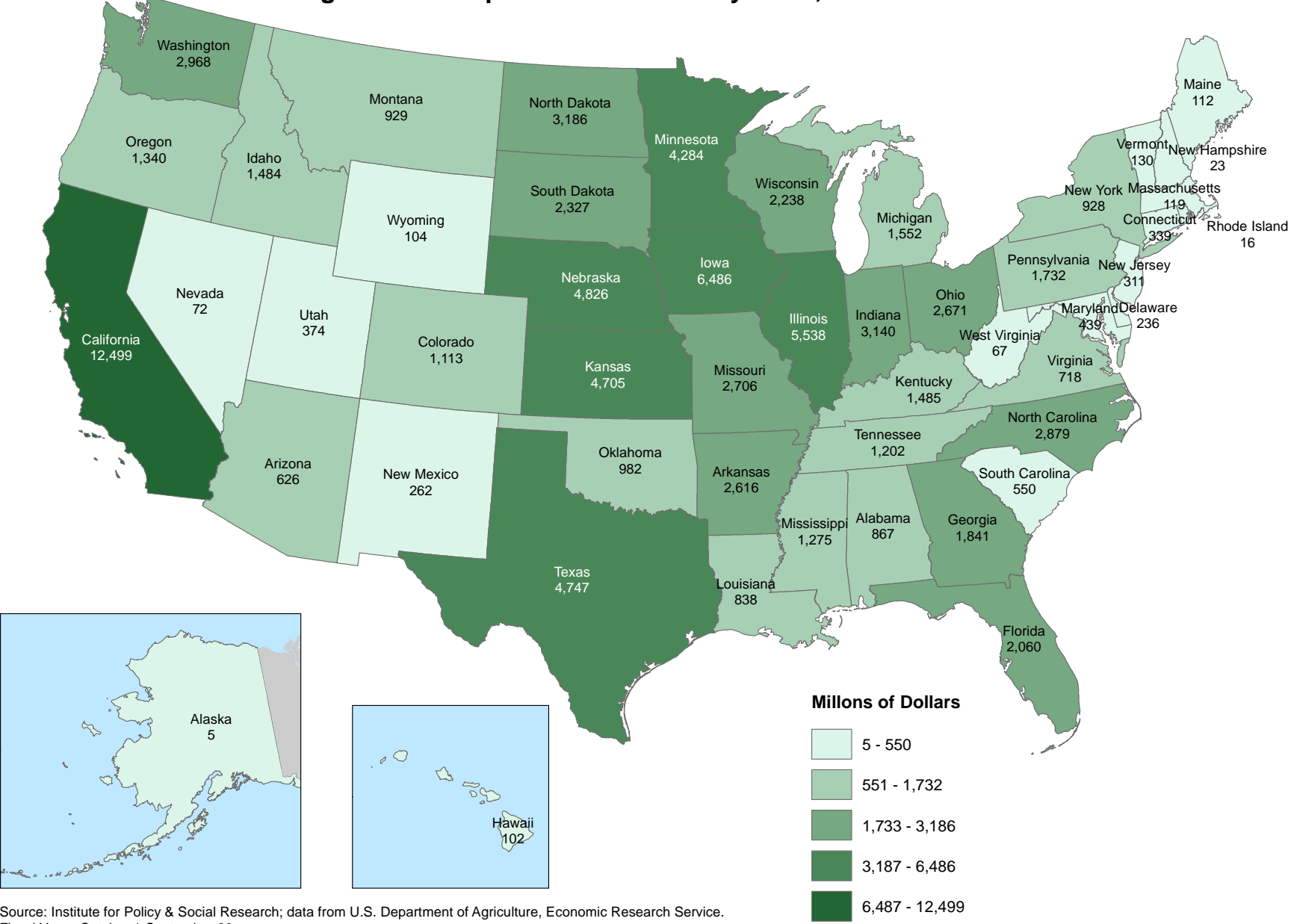

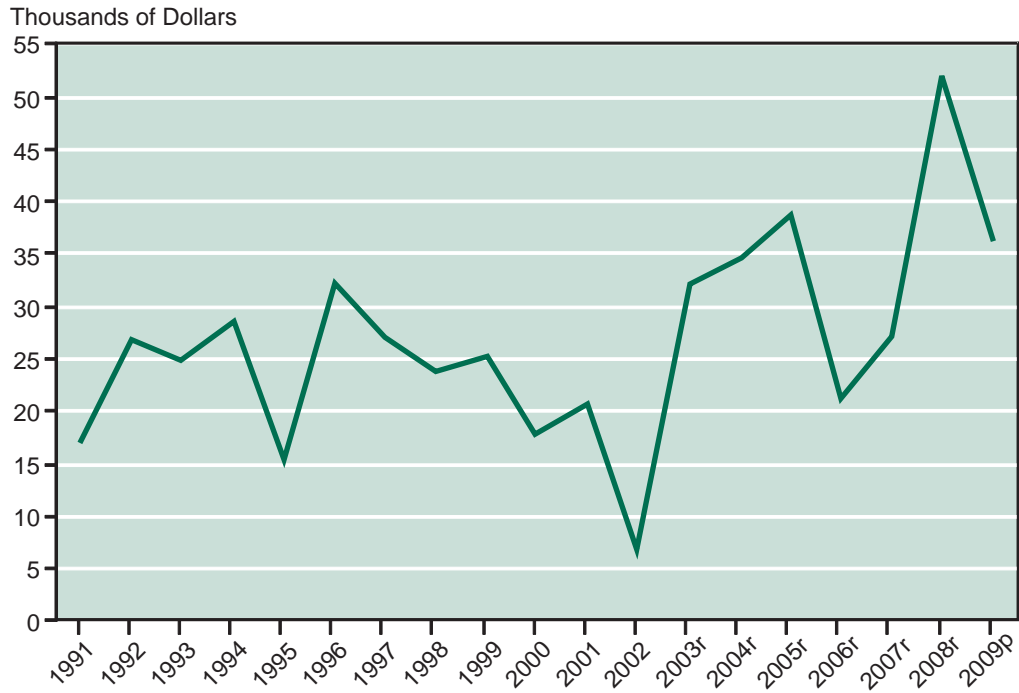
