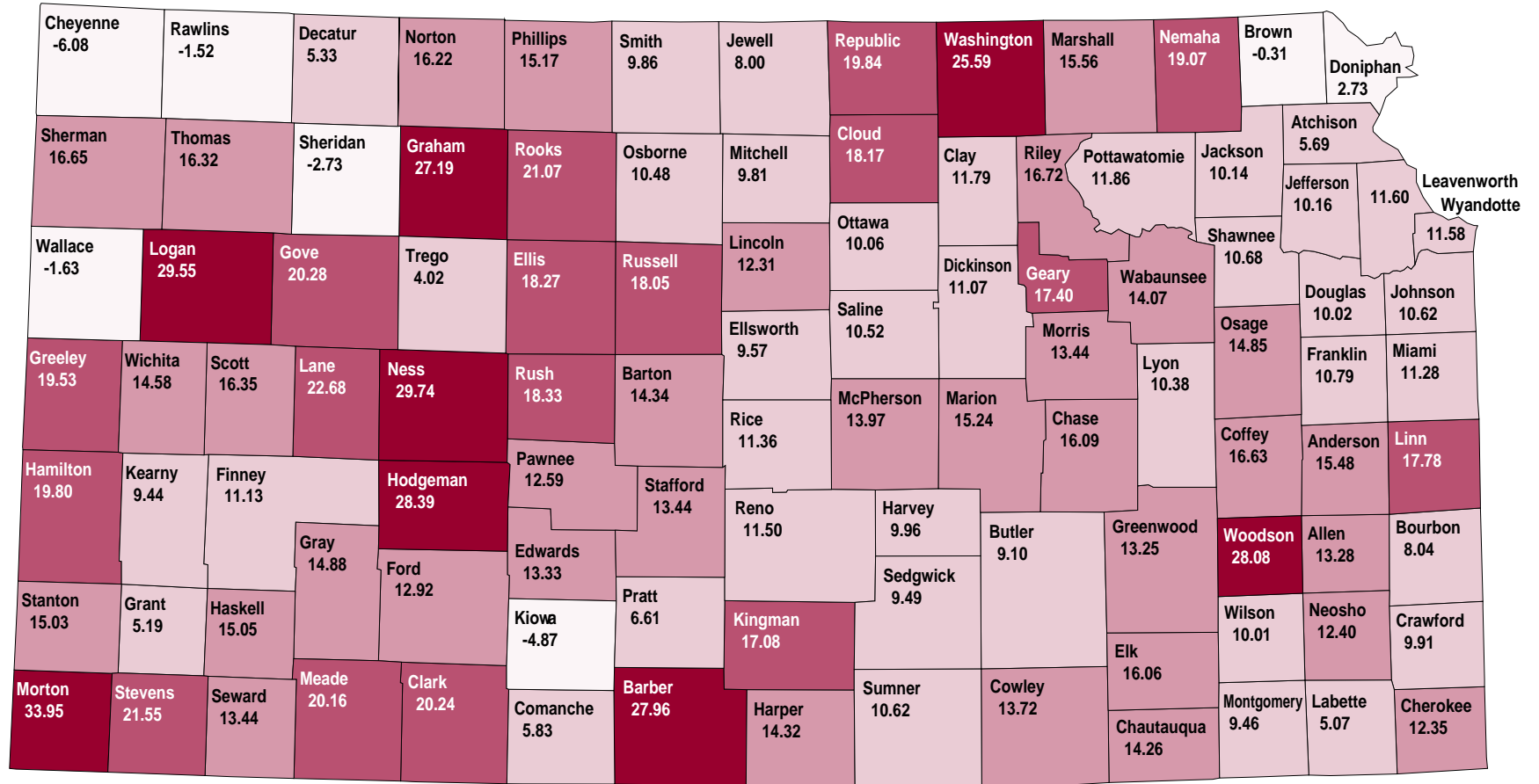

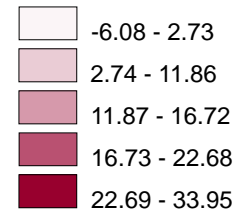
Percent Change in State Sales Tax Collections in Kansas, by County 2009-2010

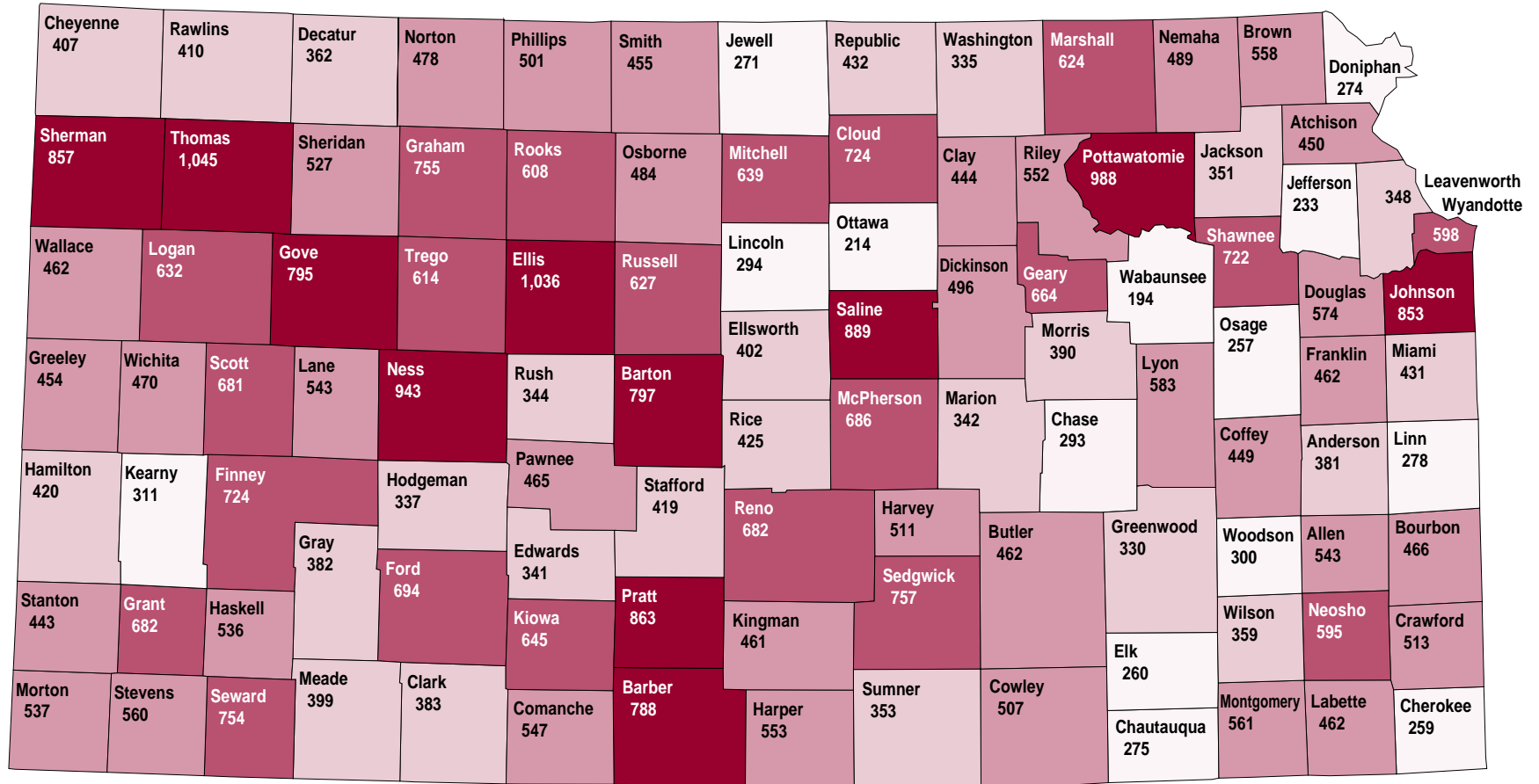

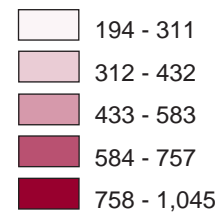
Per Capita State Sales Tax Collections in Kansas, by County Fiscal Year 2010 (in dollars)
